

Environmental policy statement


As a consultant, developer and contractor of Real Estate, Calla Woods Limited (the “Company”) is committed to managing and reducing the environmental impacts of the company’s operations.

Calla Woods recognises the importance of sustainable environmental practices in order to minimise our impact on the environment and to protect and enhance it where possible. This policy covers our key operations and all the services we provide. We will proactively work with internal and external stakeholders to ensure our environmental performance continually improves. In particular, we are committed to:

- (a) identify environmental impacts associated with the Company’s activities and set targets to continually improve environmental performance and minimise any potential negative impacts;
- (b) ensure the availability of information and resources for setting, monitoring and regular review of the Company’s environmental objectives and targets;
- (c) maintain environmental policies and standards that meet or exceed legal requirements and integrate industry best practices into operations and services;
- (d) educate and enhance employees’ environmental awareness;
- (e) take into account environmental considerations in procurement policy;
- (f) promote the use of environmentally acceptable materials and technology in the design, construction, operation and maintenance of Company premises;
- (g) communicate the Company’s environmental policy and management strategy to those with whom the Company works, including employees, contractors, suppliers, and customers; and
- (h) encourage employees, contractors, suppliers, and customers of the Company to accept responsibility for their actions and to comply with their environmental obligations.

We will also commit to an ongoing reduction of our environmental impacts and will develop a framework for the setting of appropriate environmental objectives. These objectives will set out our ambitions to reduce the impact of running our office network and to help mitigate our contribution to climate change.
